Description

- Apache Turbine is a servlet based framework that allows experienced Java developers to quickly build web applications. Turbine allows you to personalize the web sites and to use user logins to restrict access to parts of your application.

- Turbine 5.0 major upgrade in progress: First commits + discussion started.
- Apache Db Torque ORM support request accepted (related to Fulcrum Security Torque).

- Code changes in Turbine Core/Fulcrum Components subprojects let expect one or more releases in the next quarter(s).
- Need for active volunteers exist (e.g. documentation / module clean up), but (community) collaboration is evident in dev mailing list discussion and code changes.
