### Proposals

Here are some of the proposals put forth:

- [M.n] Chris Mattmann suggested the following scheme:  
*M.n*

Where *M* is the major version number.

Where *n* is the minor version number.

In this type of scheme, all *n*'s in a series are expected to be at least backwards compatible with *n*-1 through 0-9, but all *M*+1's aren't necessarily compatible with *M* or *M*-1.
