## Notes on the MyFaces Core 1.1.8 Release

Here's how you can help us test the distribution.

Download a nightly build of the distribution assemblies:

- <http://people.apache.org/builds/myfaces/nightly/>

Configure a <repository> for Maven 2:

```
<repository>
  <id>apache.snapshots</id>
  <name>Apache Snapshot Repository</name>
  <url>http://people.apache.org/repo/m2-snapshot-repository</url>
</repository>
```

And declare a dependency on the 1.1.8 snapshots:

```
<dependency>
  <groupId>org.apache.myfaces.core</groupId>
  <artifactId>myfaces-api</artifactId>
  <version>1.1.8-SNAPSHOT</version>
</dependency>
<dependency>
  <groupId>org.apache.myfaces.core</groupId>
  <artifactId>myfaces-impl</artifactId>
  <version>1.1.8-SNAPSHOT</version>
</dependency>
```

**Note:** Maven 2.0.4 will **not** download a new version if one is already present in your local repository. You will need to **delete** \$M2\_REPO/org/apache/myfaces/core to force Maven to download the new version. (Usually, \$M2\_REPO is <your home directory>/m2/repository.)

Test your application, then, let us know the results (good or bad!) on [dev at myfaces.apache.org](mailto:dev@myfaces.apache.org). (You must be subscribed to post. See: <http://myfaces.apache.org/mail-lists.html>.)

1. Preparing shared 2.0.11

- \* Trying to prepare SUCCESS!.

```

{{{
mvn release:prepare -DtagBase=https://svn.apache.org/repos/asf/myfaces/shared/branches -Dusername=lu4242 -Dscm.
password=??? -Dtag=2_0_11 -DdryRun=true
```

- Release it! FAIL.

```
mvn release:prepare -DtagBase=https://svn.apache.org/repos/asf/myfaces/shared/branches -Dusername=lu4242 -Dscm.
password=??? -Dtag=2_0_11 -Dresume=false
```

- mvn install, mvn release:rollback and try again SUCCESS!

```
mvn release:prepare -DtagBase=https://svn.apache.org/repos/asf/myfaces/shared/branches -Dusername=lu4242 -Dscm.
password=??? -Dtag=2_0_11 -Dresume=false
```

## 2. Preparing core 1.1.8

- copied trunk to temporary work branch core/branches/1\_1\_8prepare
- Set all dependencies to org.apache.myfaces.shared artifacts to version "2.0.11" instead 2.0.11-SNAPSHOT
- DryRun=true SUCCESS!

```
mvn release:prepare -DtagBase=https://svn.apache.org/repos/asf/myfaces/core/branches -Dusername=lu4242 -Dscm.
password=??? -Dtag=1_1_8 -DdryRun=true
```

- Do it! -Dresume=false SUCCESS!

```
mvn release:prepare -DtagBase=https://svn.apache.org/repos/asf/myfaces/core/branches -Dusername=lu4242 -Dscm.
password=??? -Dtag=1_1_8 -Dresume=false
```

- Move generated branch from tags to branches. Checkout 1\_1\_8 branch mvn install

## 3. Deploy on local repo

- shared 2.0.11

```
mvn clean deploy -DperformRelease=true -DaltDeploymentRepository=myfaces-local-staging::default::scp://localhost
/home/lu4242/stage/repo118 -Psign-artifacts -Dpassphrase=???
```

- core 1.1.8

```
mvn clean deploy -DperformRelease=true -DaltDeploymentRepository=myfaces-local-staging::default::scp://localhost
/home/lu4242/stage/repo118 -Psign-artifacts -Dpassphrase=???
```

\*copy manually using scp to the account on people.apache.org. Due to a bug on linux [WWW] <http://jira.codehaus.org/browse/MDEPLOY-62> deploy not work on linux. SUCCESS

```

cd home/lu4242/stage/repo
scp -p -r org lu4242@people.apache.org:/home/lu4242/public_html/myfaces118
```

## 4. JIRA Release Management

- Create 1.1.8 and 1.1.8-SNAPSHOT versions
- Find resolved issues and close them

- Unresolved issues moved to 1.1.8-SNAPSHOT

## 5. Generate assembly

- Try to do it automatically javadoc and other stuff SUCCESS. It generate myfaces-core-1.1.8-bin.tar.gz and zip,

```
cd l_1_8
mvn install -Pgenerate-assembly
cd assembly
mvn assembly:assembly -Psign-artifacts -Dpassphrase=???
```

- Create myfaces-core-1.1.8-src.tar.gz and zip manually and create .asc .md5 .sha1 for bin and src

```
openssl md5 myfaces-core-1.1.8-src.tar.gz > myfaces-core-1.1.8-src.tar.gz.md5
openssl md5 myfaces-core-1.1.8-src.zip > myfaces-core-1.1.8-src.zip.md5
openssl shal myfaces-core-1.1.8-src.tar.gz > myfaces-core-1.1.8-src.tar.gz.shal
openssl shal myfaces-core-1.1.8-src.zip > myfaces-core-1.1.8-src.zip.shal
gpg --armor --output myfaces-core-1.1.8-src.tar.gz.asc --detach-sig myfaces-core-1.1.8-src.tar.gz
gpg --armor --output myfaces-core-1.1.8-src.zip.asc --detach-sig myfaces-core-1.1.8-src.zip

openssl md5 myfaces-core-1.1.8-bin.tar.gz > myfaces-core-1.1.8-bin.tar.gz.md5
openssl md5 myfaces-core-1.1.8-bin.zip > myfaces-core-1.1.8-bin.zip.md5
openssl shal myfaces-core-1.1.8-bin.tar.gz > myfaces-core-1.1.8-bin.tar.gz.shal
openssl shal myfaces-core-1.1.8-bin.zip > myfaces-core-1.1.8-bin.zip.shal
gpg --armor --output myfaces-core-1.1.8-bin.tar.gz.asc --detach-sig myfaces-core-1.1.8-bin.tar.gz
gpg --armor --output myfaces-core-1.1.8-bin.zip.asc --detach-sig myfaces-core-1.1.8-bin.zip
```

- Copy to private account on people.apache.org

```
scp -p -r myfaces-core-1.1.8-bin* lu4242@people.apache.org:/home/lu4242/public_html/myfaces118binsrc/binaries
scp -p -r myfaces-core-1.1.8-src* lu4242@people.apache.org:/home/lu4242/public_html/myfaces118binsrc/sources
```

## 6. TCK Test

- TCK passed confirmed by Leonardo Uribe

## 7. Clirr check SUCCESS!

```
mvn clirr:check -DcomparisonVersion=1.1.6
```

## 8. VOTE

Hi,

I was running the needed tasks to get the 1.1.8 release of Apache MyFaces core out.

The artifacts passed all TCK test.

Please note that this vote concerns all of the following parts:

1. Maven artifact group "org.apache.myfaces.shared" v2.0.11 [1]
2. Maven artifact group "org.apache.myfaces.core" v1.1.8 [1]

The artifacts are deployed to my private Apache account ([1] and [3] for binary and source packages).

The release notes could be found at [4].

Also the clirr test does not show binary incompatibilities with myfaces-api.

Please take a look at the "1.1.8" artifacts and vote!

Please note: This vote is "majority approval" with a minimum of three +1 votes (see [3]).

## 9. Vote closed, starting distribution

- copy on <http://www.apache.org/dist/myfaces/source> and <http://www.apache.org/dist/myfaces/binaries>

```
cd /home/lu4242/public_html/myfaces118binsrc/sources
cp * /www.apache.org/dist/myfaces/source
cd /home/lu4242/public_html/myfaces118binsrc/binaries
cp * /www.apache.org/dist/myfaces/binaries
```

- copy shared on <http://www.people.apache.org/repo/m2-ibiblio-rsync-repository/org/apache/myfaces/shared> SUCCESS

Alternative for manual copy:

```
mvn clean deploy -DaltDeploymentRepository=myfaces-staging::default::scpexe://people.apache.org/www/people.apache.org/repo/m2-ibiblio-rsync-repository -Psign-artifacts -DperformRelease=true -Dpassphrase=???
```

- copy core on <http://www.people.apache.org/repo/m2-ibiblio-rsync-repository/org/apache/myfaces/core> SUCCESS

Alternative for manual copy:

```
mvn clean deploy -DaltDeploymentRepository=myfaces-staging::default::scpexe://people.apache.org/www/people.apache.org/repo/m2-ibiblio-rsync-repository -Psign-artifacts -Dpassphrase=?? -DperformRelease=true
```

MyFaces Core is a JavaServer(tm) Faces 1.1 implementation as specified by JSR-127. MyFaces Core has passed Sun's JSR-127 TCK and is 100% compliant with the JSR-127 specification.

Please note this release also contains a fix for:

MYFACES-2749 Encrypted View State does not include Message Authentication Code (MAC)

This fix prevents padding oracle attack on view state when client side state saving is used.

MyFaces Core 1.1.8 is available in both binary and source distributions.
