Apache XML-RPC is an implementation of the XML-RPC specification. As the name suggests, the specification describes XML based remote procedure calls, much like the [Java API for XML based RPC \(JAX-RPC\)](#). However, XML-RPC is language neutral (thus portable) and much simpler and easier to handle than JAX-RPC or EJB. See the [Projects home page](#) for more information.
