Ideally, each file gets a comment header and each directory contains a README file that will list the following information for files and directories respectively:

## **parsed during**

## **parsed by**

## **scope**

`\${renderedContent}`

## **overrides**

`\${renderedContent}`

## **can be overridden by**

`\${renderedContent}`

## **manual modification**

`\${renderedContent}`

## **manual modification implies**

`\${renderedContent}`

## **modified/generated by**

`\${renderedContent}`
