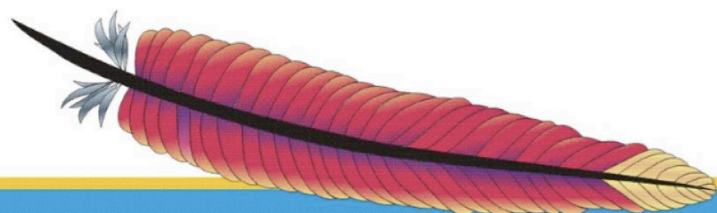


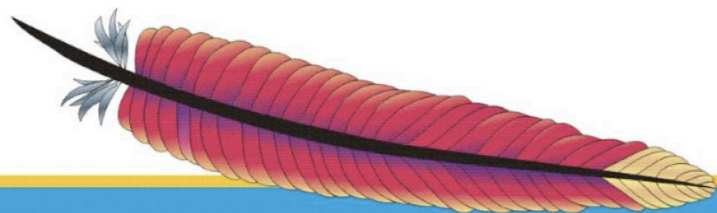

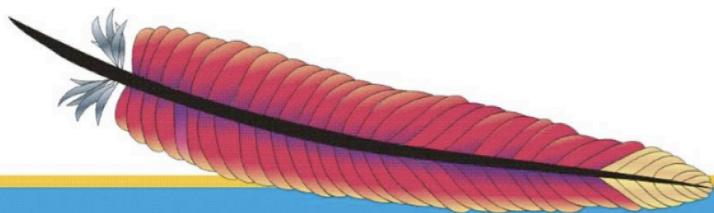
## Goals

- Use Maven to build .NET applications
- Share concepts with other platforms (Java) where it makes sense
- Make it a natural fit for the .NET development environment



## Existing Features

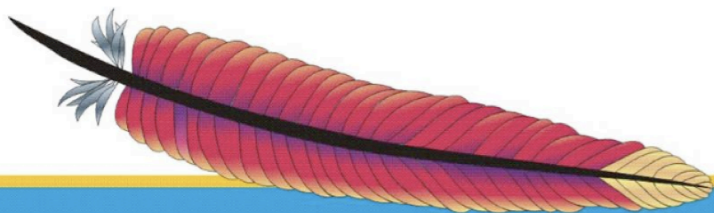
- Command-line Build
- Support For C#, VB, .NET Compact Profile
- Support for Frameworks 1.1, 2.0, 3.0
- Custom Profiles
- NUnit Testing
- XSD and WSDL Generation
- Webapp Packaging and Deployment
- Resource Generation
- Signing of Assemblies
- ... and other features already provided by Maven





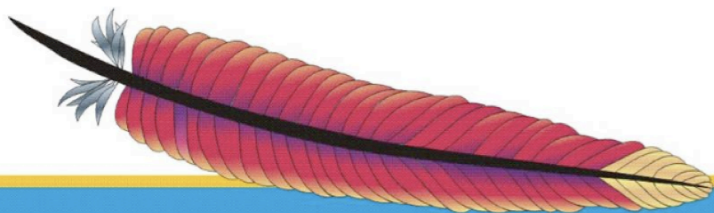
## Writing Plugins

- Maven plugins can be written in .NET languages
  - Currently only supported on Windows



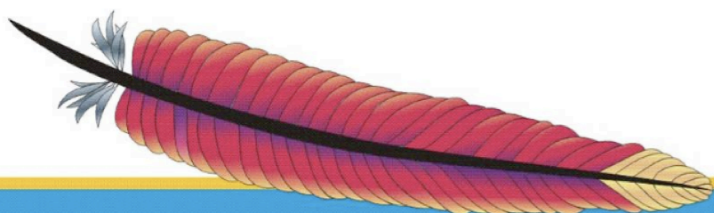
## Visual Studio Integration

- Integration of the build lifecycle
- Resolving and Adding Dependencies
- Keeps the project and pom.xml in sync
