

Ozone HA Components

- OM Ratis Server
 - Each OM node starts Ratis Server. Ratis Server API is used to submit request to Ratis.
- OM State Machine
 - Ratis after appending transaction to log, will call State Machine to apply the transaction by calling applyTransaction.
 - \circ In apply Transaction actual logic for writeRequest will be executed.
- Table Cache
 - \circ Each Table has cache, which is an in-memory map to store the table info.
 - Cache has Eviction policies. Current eviction policies supported are NEVER, CUSTOM.

Ozone HA Components

- Double Buffer
 - Each OM node will have double buffer, when write request completes its execution it adds it's entries to table cache.
 - Double Buffer maintains two buffers.
 - ReadyBuffer
 - CurrentBuffer
 - Double Buffer has a daemon thread, checks if there are any entries in its currentBuffer, swap buffers and flush the entries to DB.

Steps required to handle write requests in OM.

- Developer need to implement two abstract classes.
 - OMClientRequest
 - OMClientResponse

OMClientRequest :

- PreExecute.
 - Perform steps need to be happen on only leader OM.
 - Like allocating blocks,
 - Setting creation/modification time.
 - Set userInfo.
- ValidateAndUpdateCache.
 - Request validation, and update the cache.


OMClientResponse:

- addToDBBatch.
 - Implement the logic to add the response to DB batch.

How write requests are handled in OM HA

- Request is received from Client through Rpc.
- Once request is received, check if isLeader(), and perform preExecute steps like allocating block, setting creation/modification time and set userInfo.
- After that submit request to ratis.
- After ratis got quorum, and write entries to log, it calls stateMachine to apply transaction.
- In apply transaction we perform validation, execute actual request, add the response data to cache.
- Once we get the client response, we add the response to double buffer to flush to DB.
