Editor Home Pages

When making changes, it's a good idea to note who wrote them as a courtesy to other Wiki editors who may want to refactor or edit it later.

The [HomePage](#) mechanism is how this is done; for example, let's say you add some text like the second one below. Add a link to your name at the end of the added text:

- With Sendmail, Spamassassin can be called for every user by editing `/etc/procmailrc` . More details at *link*.
- An alternative is to use the smtp-vilter high-performance content filter using the sendmail milter API which has a backend for Spamassassins spamd. More details at *otherlink*. (YourName)

If you prefer not to place email addresses on your [HomePage](#) you can add a link to your website instead. Make it so it points to your contacts page and not to your website index. (CatalinIonescu)

Once you save the page, the `YourName` text will appear as a link, since it is formatted in mixed case (in other words, as a [WikiName](#)). Go to create that page, use the [HomepageTemplate](#) as a template, and fill in the details.
