Running Solr under Daemontools

1. install daemontools
2. create /etc/solr
3. create a user and group called solr
4. create shell script /etc/solr/run (edit to taste; I'm using the default jetty that comes with solr)

```
#!/bin/sh
exec 2>&1
cd /usr/local/apache-solr-1.3.0/example
exec setuidgid solr java -jar start.jar
```

5. create /etc/solr/log/run containing:

```
#!/bin/sh
exec setuidgid solr multilog t ./main
```

6. In -s /etc/solr /service/solr

that is all. as long as you've got svscan set to launch when the system boots, solr will run and auto-restart on crashes. logs will be in /service/solr/log/main (auto-rotated).
