Committer Election Process



Like many other documents, this is a continual work in progress.

This is based on:

• Electing new committers

Our process:

- Send vote_committer.txt
 - $^{\circ}\,\,$ It is okay to start a DISCUSS thread first if you are unsure about the election
 - Wait three days (or longer) and tally the vote
 - Only proceed if the vote was successful
- Send result_committer.txt
- Send invite_committer.txt
 - Only go to the next step if they accept
- Send accept_committer.txt
- Wait until:
 - You see the CLA or CCLA acknowledged by the ASF secretary
 - As soon as you see this, request account creation (access for ASF members and the CouchDB project chair):

 - ICLAs here, in case you need them:
 - https://svn.apache.org/repos/private/documents/iclas/
 - O There is no need to grant karma
 - · Wait until the account is created
- Send done_committer.txt
- Send announce-committer.txt
- · Follow the new committer from the CouchDB Twitter account
- Post a Tweet
 - "Pleased to announce that %NAME% has been elected as the newest CouchDB committer!"
- Post to Google+ page, Facebook page, and LinkedIn page
 - Post the same message to the each site.
- Add committer to JIRA groups

- Add committer to AdminGroup on wiki
- Add committer to Individual Users Group on cwiki

- Set flags on #couchdb, #couchdb-dev, and #couchdb-meeting. This is done by running
 - /msg chanserv flags #couchdb [USERS_NICKNAME] +ARVfiorstv
